

Douro - Claudia's 2009 red

Claudia is the name of our winemaker at Quevedo. Claudia's is a complex and rich wine, made with hand-picked grapes from vineyards located in Quinta Vale d'Agodinho, Ferradosa area, around 200 meters above the sea level. Because of its volume and concentration, you may need to open in advance in order to fully appreciate this wine. This is the wine Claudia likes to share with her friends.



Tasting Notes

Dark ruby colour;

Aroma: rich red and black fruit flavours with blackberries and plums standing out;

Palate firm, with a nice tannic structure, though soft and balanced with a firm acidity..

Elaboration

The grapes were sorted, pressed and fermented in stainless steel vats with long maceration; then it aged for 12 months on new French oak barrels where malolatic fermentation took place

Varietals

Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Touriga Nacional, Tinto Cão, Tinta Amarela
