Grapes / Varieties - Touriga Nacional (60%), Tinta Roriz (40%).

Tasting notes

Color: lively youthful cherry-ruby color

On the nose, red ripe fruits, combining with discreet wood and chocolate flavours.

On the palate is elegant and balanced, with a rich fruit taste and well integrated tannins.

Winemaking details

2012 was a very dry year with around 50% of the average rainfall. Vines produced 35% less than average.

Totally destemmed grapes, followed by a slow fermentation with temperature control up to 25° C. Soft filtration. Bottled in April 2014.
