

Quevedo 1996 Colheita: Elegant and crisp, with a sweet end, this is a strong on nutty flavors and beautifully balanced. As it pulls itself together after opening, it delivers a burst of acidity and a whiff of brandy, becoming a bit more nuanced and interesting. This is not a blockbuster, rather one aimed more at those who appreciate the elegance and refreshing acidity, but it gradually grew on me and stayed in balance. It is a charming youngster. 89 points. Quevedo - Quinta Vale d'Agodinho 2010 Vintage - Clear, intense ruby colour. Intense in ripe black fruits and candied fruit, black plum, figs, and in floral notes reminding of violets and heath, elegant. The mouth reveals the dark chocolate and the mulberries, tobacco leaf, balsamic notes, which join the aromatic profile, great acidity and plenty of freshness, smooth tannins, powerful finish. 17.7 points, Best of the Tasting. Sharp on the nose, aggressive blackcurrants with a twist of mustard leaves. Incredibly thick texture, by far the thickest of the 2008 samples tasted. Mouth-filling sweet fruit, deep and concentrated; rich and with balanced put pronounced tannins. Massive fruit on the aftertaste, big finish full of dark chocolate and ripe blueberries. 92-94/100.
